Am I eligible for a GMAT Waiver?

Lipscomb Graduate School of Business offers a GMAT waiver to those applicants who meet the following criteria:

- **PMBA/MBA/MACC** – Minimum 10 years of professional work experience AND a 3.0 undergraduate GPA or higher.
- **MHR** – Minimum 10 years of professional work experience OR a 3.0 undergraduate GPA or higher.

All GMAT waivers must be approved through the admissions committee. Resumes and transcripts must be submitted to document work experience and undergrad grade point averages. To request a GMAT waiver, contact your recruiter at onedegreeaway@lipscomb.edu.
